

ALAN H. VICORY, JR.

Alan H. Vicory, Jr. received his B.S. in Civil Engineering from Virginia Military Institute in 1974. That same year he joined the consulting firm of Greeley & Hansen Engineers in Richmond, Virginia where he was involved in water and wastewater studies and designs. Interspersed with his employment at Greeley & Hansen was duty as a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Officer.

In 1979, Vicory joined the staff of the Ohio River Valley Water Sanitation Commission (ORSANCO) as an environmental engineer. He advanced from this position to Manager of Technical Services and was subsequently appointed as Executive Director and Chief Engineer in 1987. ORSANCO is an interstate agency established in 1948, by state compact, to control and abate water pollution in the Ohio Basin. Members of the Commission represent Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, and the United States and are appointed by the respective state Governors and the President. The Commission is a watershed-based regulatory agency and sets standards for discharges to the Ohio River, operates water monitoring systems, responds to spills, conducts surveys and serves to coordinate water pollution control on a river management basis.

Vicory is a licensed professional engineer in Ohio and Virginia and is board certified in the area of water and wastewater by the American Academy of Environmental Engineers (AAEE) and is a past president of the Academy.

He is active in the Water Environment Federation (WEF) and international affairs through the International Water Association (IWA –Former Chairman of the Watershed and River Basin Management Specialist Group and currently on the Association’s Strategic Council). Also, he is a Past President of the Association of State and Interstate Water Pollution Control Administrators. He is a member of the American Water Works Association and the National Society of Professional Engineers (NSPE). He is the recipient of awards sponsored by AAEE and NSPE and the National Association of Clean Water Agencies. Currently he is Vice-Chairman of the board of the Water Environment Research Foundation.

Vicory has provided contributions to published texts, published and presented numerous professional papers, has provided keynote remarks at several technical and professional conferences and has serves on
